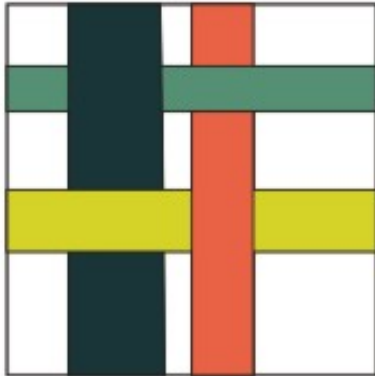




Oakville Quilters' Guild
Modern Block of the Month
October - Woven



Block size: 12.5" unfinished

You will need:

- Four coloured fabrics
- Background fabric

This block looks complicated, but with partial seams, it's pretty simple to make.

Cutting Directions (label your pieces as you go to keep track of them)

Background Fabric

- A1 – 2.5" x 3"
- A3 – 2.5" x 2.5"
- B1 – 1.5" x 2.5"
- B3 – 4.5" x 2.5"
- C1 – 2.5" x 4.5"
- C3 – 1.5" x 4.5"
- D1 – 4.5" x 4.5"
- D3 – 4.5" x 3"
- E – 1.5" x 3"

Woven Strips (coloured fabric)

- Fabric 1 (blue)**
- A4 – 3.5" x 6.5"
 - C2 – 3.5 x 4.5"
- Fabric 2 (teal)**
- A2 – 2.5" x 2"
 - B4 – 7.5" x 2"

- Fabric 3 (pink)**
- B2 – 2.5" x 2.5"
 - D4 – 2.5" x 9"

- Fabric 4 (yellow)**
- C4 – 6.5" x 2.5"
 - D2 – 4.5" x 2.5"

Assemble sections A, B, C and D as shown in the diagram, pressing to the dark fabric or the largest piece.

Align background piece E to the bottom corner of A4. Sew E to A4 leaving about 1" unsewn at the top.

Section C will now line up the A/E section. Sew on section C followed by D and then B.

Piece A4 will now line up nicely with the rest of the block. Finish the seam starting at piece E and sewing to the edge of the block.
