


Oakville Quilters' Guild Modern Block of the Month May Block 2 – Bordered Star



Block size: 12.5" unfinished

Cutting Instructions:

■ Background – 1 – 7 ½" square

8 – 2 ½" x 4 ½" rect.

4 – 2 ½" squares

Colour $1 - 1 - 7 \frac{1}{2}$ square

8 - 2 ½" squares

Colour $2-2-2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

1 – 3" square

• Colour 3 − 2 − 2 ½" squares

1 - 3" square

- Colour 4 $2-2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares 1-3" square
 - Colour 5 2-2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares 1-3" square

Make the Corner Squares

- Place the background and Colour 1 7 ½" squares right sides together.
- Sew ¼" away from the edge on all four sides.
- Cut diagonally both ways to make four HSTs.
 Square blocks to 4 ½".
- Place a 2 ½" background square right side together on top of a HST as shown in the image.
- Sew on the diagonal and trim excess to ¼" seam allowance.
- Make four blocks.

Make the Flying Geese

- Use the flip and sew method to make flying geese with the 2 ½" x 4 ½" background squares and the 2 ½" focal fabric squares.
- Make four flying geese that have Colour 1 on both sides.
- Make two flying geese with Colour 3 and Colour 2 as shown in the picture.
- Make two flying geese with Colour 5 and Colour 4 as shown in the picture.

Make the Half Square Triangles and Assemble the Block

- Make four HSTs using the 3" squares in the following combinations: Colour 2/Colour 5 (2 blocks) and Colour 3/Colour 4 (2 blocks).
- Place the squares right sides together and sew ½" from the diagonal on each side. Cut along the diagonal. Trim to 2 ½".
- Arrange the block as shown in the block diagram and sew together
