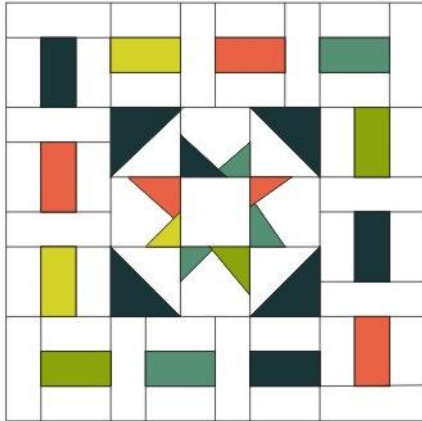

Modern Block of the Month
April – Film Strip



Block size: 12.5" unfinished

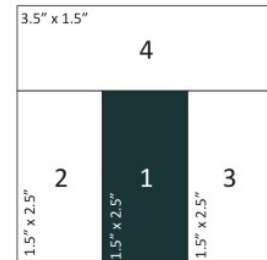
You will need:

- 12 – 2.5" x 1.5" rectangles of focal fabrics for "slides"
- 12 – 3.5" x 1.5" background fabric
- 24 – 2.5" x 1.5" background fabric
- 2 – 3.5" x 3.5" focal fabric for HSTs around star
- 2 – 3.5" x 3.5" background fabric for HSTs around star
- 5 – 2.5" x 2.5" background fabric for wonky star
- Scraps of four focal fabrics for wonky star (8 pieces)

Feel free to make whatever type of star you want to go in the middle, so long as it measures 6.5" by 6.5" unfinished.

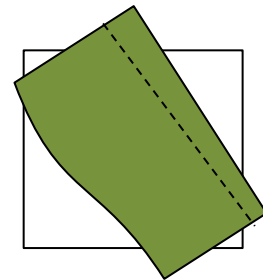
Make the film strip

- Sew 2.5" x 1.5" background pieces on both sides of the focal print "slide".
- Attach the 3.5" x 1.5" background rectangle to one side to finish the film strip unit.
- Make 12 units



Make the Star

- Position scrap of fabric over top of one of the background squares as shown in the figure. Sew along the edge with a 1/4" seam.
- Press unit with the main fabric facing up. Flip your square over and trim away excess main colour fabric so that you once again have a 2.5" square. Trim away any excess seam allowance.
- Repeat to add triangle to the left side of the square.
- Make 4 units.



Assemble the block

- Make 4 HSTs with the 3.5" squares.
 - Sew 1/4" away from the diagonal, cut down the diagonal.
 - Trim down blocks to 2.5" unfinished.
- Assemble the star block with the HST corners as shown in the diagram.
- Assemble slide units to make the border as shown to finish the block.
